



on Saturday 18th morning at 9:30am for a brief act of worship – and breakfast!



Revd Ann's Sabbatical 1 May 2023 to 22 August 2023

Revd Ann is planning to use her time on sabbatical to explore resources in Art, Music, Prayer, and Spirituality, and to focus on a deeper relationship with God.

She intends to use the experience to develop a creative prayer resource for the Circuit and others and develop prayer and spirituality among our congregations. It will be on a theme of "Listening to God - and Listening to Others".

Janet Griffin is leading the 'Sabbatical Support Group, which was convened to pull together all the requirements and provide support for the Circuit.

Introductory Notes

Background

Through a combination of sabbatical and annual leave, Revd Ann Fox will be out of the Circuit from 1 May 2023 to 22 August 2023. The aim of the Sabbatical Support Group is to try and predict and cover issues which might arise during this period, supporting Ann and each other, calling upon the Circuit and District resources as required.

It is important that we in our congregations understand that, apart from the last two weeks, this is not a holiday. To quote from the Methodist Church guidelines, "a sabbatical is a period of release from the ordinary duties of a presbyteral appointment, for re-equipping, refreshment, and renewal. The Church believes sabbaticals are a vital part of ministry and therefore they are compulsory for all presbyters. They normally have to be taken every seventh year of travel."

The Covid pandemic brought its challenges to the Circuit during and shortly after Ann's arrival, which meant we had to find ways to work differently. Not long after the churches began to fully reopen, Ann had a period of sickness and took time out to recuperate after a major operation, which meant the Circuit and Ann had to find ways to keep the Circuit running effectively until she had fully recovered. It is important, therefore, that Ann feels able to take this time away from Circuit to be refreshed and renewed.

Ann is planning to use her time on sabbatical to explore resources in Art, Music, Prayer, and Spirituality, and to focus on a deeper relationship with God. She would like to use the experience to develop a creative prayer resource for the Circuit and others and develop prayer and spirituality among our congregations. It will be on a theme of "Listening to God, and Listening to Others".

The intention is, so far as possible, to isolate Ann from the life of the Circuit and, to that end:

Issue	Action	By Whom?
Preaching Plan:	Ann's preaching appointments will clearly leave a large gap in the preaching plan, both for ordinary services and for Holy Communion. The intention is to ask Local Preachers to offer additional services and to call upon neighbouring Circuits for help as necessary. Holy Communion services will be presbyter-led by Rev Steve, Supernumeraries and Visitors. Eileen can offer extended Holy Communion for home or hospice visits.	SJ/EC

Pastoral Emergencies	These will be picked up by Rev Steve and Eileen. If there are any deaths, Ann would like to be made aware, but will not be involved in counselling / funeral arrangements. Notify funeral directors.	SJ/EC AF diaried for April 2023
Special Services	District Presidential Visit: Tadcaster church had requested the Chair of District (Revd Leslie Newton) to preach at their chapel anniversary service on 9 July. This now coincides with the President of Conference's visit to the District that weekend. It has therefore been arranged that the service will be led by the President (Revd Gill Newton) with the Chair, and it will be a Circuit Service.	SJ
Weddings / Baptisms	None	
School Assemblies	None in the diary – Ann is on a rota basis for St James Wetherby, so this will be dealt with.	
Ecumenical groups	Tadcaster Churches Together (Ann is Chair) is aware and the Vice-Chair has been notified for the meetings that are planned. Plus, Eileen and Maureen Dixon will be present at the meetings. Wetherby Churches Together are aware, and Heather Shipman and Andrew Marshall will be present at the meetings.	
Community Events	King's Coronation on Sat 6 May. Events at local churches are yet to be arranged. There will be a Circuit Service on Sunday 30 April at Wetherby (Ann's last Sunday in Circuit). This will give churches chance to make their own plans, e.g. with Churches Together etc., for the Coronation weekend (which includes Bank Holiday Monday).	
Special Projects – Outreach / Building	Outreach at Appleton Roebuck, Church Fenton, Tadcaster and Ulleskelf covered by Eileen. Outreach at Wetherby ongoing.	EC

	Building project: We are about to start fundraising for Ulleskelf's Hall Roof with the assistance of John McCarthy (Wetherby) and Revd Uell Kennedy.	JM/UK
Work-related Emails, Phone-Calls, and Mail	The out of office message will be on for emails with details of who to contact. Similarly, an out of office message will also be on the phone system. Ann will be at home for most of the time and will deal with the mail.	AF
	Churches will be asked not to copy Ann into emails. Instead, if there is anything that she needs to know about, please forward them onto Janet Griffin who will keep a file for Ann, and will pass on any urgent emails that require action.	JG
Return to Work process	Although Ann returns to work on 22 August, it would be grossly unfair to expect her to be able to pick up everything from day one. The first two weeks, therefore, will be a transition period to allow a graduated return to work. On the first day back there will be a CLT catch up meeting. Each church in the Circuit to keep a log of issues e.g. pastoral, property, etc.	
Sharing the fruits	Ann anticipates preparing a resource that can be shared around the Circuit and will be able to talk about this during a Circuit Service.	
Other issues Special Circuit Newsletter to inform congregations of plans. Janet to draft and agree with Steve and Eileen.		JG
